**Year 4 School Ventures Opportunity
Mini Residential 24th- 26th March 2023**



Dear Parent/Carer,

We have been given a fantastic opportunity to offer all of our pupils in Year 4 the chance to experience an outdoor residential activity weekend.

The residential will take place between **Friday 24th and Sunday 26th March 2023.**

We will be staying at Ferny Crofts Scout Activity Centre near Beaulieu. The children will be staying in single sex dormitories and will be supervised by school staff, volunteers from St Mary's Church, Bransgore, as well as Rev Dr Benjamin Sargent and Mrs Sargent and staff from the activity centre.

Parents will need to arrange for their child to be dropped off at Ferny Crofts on Friday 24th at 11.30am (children are **NOT** expected in school on the Friday morning) and collected from the centre on Sunday 26th March at 2.15pm.

The cost of the visit should be £79 per pupil but due to a donation from the church and a supplement paid from our school budget, we are offering this trip for only **£50 per pupil.**

This is a voluntary contribution, however, if we do not receive enough contributions we will not be able to go ahead with this mini residential. We receive funding for any families eligible for Pupil Premium, so the cost for these pupils will be paid for from this funding.

I have attached some additional information for you to share with your child to help you decide if you would like them to attend. There is also a booking form which parents will need to complete and return to school by **Friday 6th January 2023.**

Please make an online payment via Scopay. If payment is a problem, please let us know and we will see what we can do to help. The money can be paid in one lump sum or in two instalments between now and March. The suggested instalment dates are:

February 10th - £25

March 20th - £25

Full payment for the visit will need to be received by Wednesday 23rd March at the latest.
